Winemaker's Tasting Notes:

"Experiencing this wine is akin to being flooded by a blanket of warm light. Coming back to this wine year after year is a reminder that the Winfield Vineyard is a very giving site, producing wines that have so much to say in a broad, resonant tone.

"The flavors are lush, sumptuous and deeply expressive. The wine shows off a regal, deep plum hue in the glass. Aromas of clove oil, peppermint, beef blood, iron, and crushed blackberries can be detected even before putting your nose in the glass. The mouth feel of this wine is incredibly sleek.

"The trajectory, from entry to finish, is marked by notes of cassis reduction, fresh loam, lilac, toasted cedar bark, black cherry, and distressed leather. The finely integrated tannin structure and fresh minerality provide an uplifting effect on the palate. The long airy finish is filled with light floral and red fruit notes that go on for nearly a minute."
